



PROTOCOL FOR COMMUNICATION WITH THE ARCHDUKE OF DUCKIONARY

Addressing the Archduke:

When communicating with the Archduke or any member of the Archducal Family, it is important to observe proper protocol and decorum.

Address of the Archducal House:

Correspondence intended for His Royal Highness the Archduke should be directed to the following address:

*HRH Archduke Arthur I of Duckionary
Palais Archiducal
Stocket 17
4782 Sankt Florian am Inn
Austria - Europe*

Formal letters should begin with “Your Royal Highness” and conclude with “I have the honor to remain, Your Royal Highness's humble and obedient servant” or “Most Honourable Royal Highness Most Submissive”.

Expectations for correspondence:

The Archduke reviews a significant portion of his correspondence daily, overseen by one of his Private Secretaries.

The letters sent are valued, and His Royal Highness takes a genuine interest in the messages received.

Correspondence not receiving a response:

The Archduke does not involve himself in macronational political or personal disputes. Any letters requesting such intervention will receive a standard response reflecting this policy.
