

a) Privacy Policy

1. Data Controller

The data controller within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Austrian Data Protection Act (DSG) is:

2. General Information on Data Processing

We generally process the personal data of users of this website only to the extent necessary to provide a fully functional website and to deliver our content and services. Depending on the purpose of processing, the legal bases include, in particular, Article 6(1)(a) (consent), (b) (pre-contractual measures/performance), and (f) (legitimate interest) of the GDPR, as well as—where political opinions or memberships are concerned—Article 9(2)(a) or (d) of the GDPR.

3. Website Provision / Hosting (Wix.com)

This website is operated using the website builder platform provided by Wix.com Ltd. (or the respective Wix group company, which may be headquartered outside the EU/EEA). When you visit the site, technical access data (so-called server log files: IP address, date/time, page accessed, browser used, referrer URL) is automatically processed. The legal basis is Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (legitimate interest in the secure and stable provision of the website).

Since Wix may transfer data to third countries (including the U.S. and Israel), this is done on the basis of the European Commission's Standard Contractual Clauses or—in the case of Israel—on the basis of an adequacy decision.

4. Cookies and Similar Technologies

This website uses cookies. Technically necessary cookies (e.g., for the basic functionality of the website) are set in accordance with Section 165(3) of the TKG 2021 and Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR. All cookies that are not technically necessary (e.g., statistics/marketing cookies, if used) are set only after explicit, active consent has been given in accordance with Section 165(3) of the TKG 2021 in conjunction with Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR. Consent may be revoked at any time with future effect via Cookie Settings/Consent Banner Link.

5. Social Media Links

The website includes links to our profiles on X, Facebook, YouTube, Instagram, TikTok, Patreon, and Flickr. Provided that these are merely links and not embedded as actively loading plugins, they are simply links; simply clicking on an icon does not transmit any data to the respective provider. Only after you are redirected to the respective platform does that platform's own privacy policy apply, over which we have no control.

6. Contacting Us (Email)

When you contact us via email (partei@duckionary.com), the data you provide (including your name, email address, and message content) will be processed for the purpose of handling your inquiry. The legal basis is Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR (processing of inquiries/pre-contractual measures, e.g., in the case of interest in membership) or Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (legitimate interest in responding). The data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer necessary to achieve the purpose and there are no legal retention obligations to the contrary.

7. Party Membership / Support

Individuals who wish to become members or actively support the party provide the party with personal data (e.g., name, address, date of birth, contact information). Since membership in a political party allows inferences to be drawn about political opinions, this constitutes a special category of personal data pursuant to Article 9 of the GDPR. Data processing is based on explicit consent (Article 9(2)(a) of the GDPR) in connection with joining the party and—to the extent necessary—to fulfill the

obligations arising from the Political Parties Act of 2012 (Article 9(2)(g) of the GDPR in conjunction with the Political Parties Act). Member data is not disclosed to third parties outside the party organization, unless required by law (e.g., accountability obligations to the Court of Auditors).

8. Recipients of Data

Data is transferred to third parties only to the extent necessary for contract or membership processing, due to a legal obligation (e.g., the Political Parties Act, audits by the Court of Auditors), or based on consent that has been granted. Technical service providers (in particular Wix.com as a hosting and website provider) are engaged as data processors in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR.

9. Retention Period

Personal data is stored only for as long as is necessary for the respective purpose of processing or as required by statutory retention periods.

10. Rights of Data Subjects

You have the following rights in accordance with statutory provisions:
