



FOREIGN POLICY OF THE PARLIAMENTARY MONARCHY OF DUCKIONARY

PREAMBLE

Following its declaration of independence in 2018, the Parliamentary Monarchy of Duckionary has adopted the declarative theory of statehood. This theory asserts that a state, characterized by defined territory, a stable population, a functional government, and the capacity to engage in international relations, is inherently acknowledged by the government of Duckionary. Moreover, the Parliamentary Monarchy of Duckionary grants de jure recognition through formal communication from the Archduke of Duckionary to states upon request. The nation has forged treaties for mutual recognition and diplomatic ties with other states, alongside acquiring membership and observer status in diverse intergovernmental organizations. This foreign policy endeavors to formalize diplomatic connections and enhance participation in the realm of intergovernmental affairs. Duckionary emphasizes the importance of reciprocal recognition among micronations, acknowledging the varied territorial claims, populations, and governance frameworks within this community.

DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH FOREIGN STATES

For nations seeking to establish diplomatic ties with Duckionary, adherence to the following prerequisites is imperative:

- **A historical background spanning at least 2 years**
- **Commitment to peaceful resolutions**
- **Exhibition of professionalism in conduct**
- **Possession of a well-defined and stable governance structure**
- **Maintenance of an official website and email**
- **Proficiency in English or German to facilitate communication with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs**

NEUTRALITY

Duckionary adheres to a policy of neutrality concerning inter-State conflicts, especially those involving nations with which Duckionary maintains diplomatic relations. The nation remains resolute in its neutral stance, impervious to external pressures or requests. Duckionary refrains from both yielding to and issuing ultimatums to other states.

Currently, treaties are exclusively focused on either mutual recognition, union, military cooperation, or post-agreements. Each treaty is collaboratively developed.

The Archduke is responsible for signing international treaties and agreements. Discussions regarding diplomatic relations are conducted solely through the Foreign Ministry at mfa@duckionary.com
